

**COMPETITION FOR QUALIFICATIONS AND EXAMS,
FOR THE ADMISSION TO PHD RESEARCH COURSES - 38TH CYCLE
WITH ADMINISTRATION HEADQUARTERS AT
THE UNIVERSITY *LUIGI VANVITELLI* CAMPANIA**

Art. 1

Establishment and competition notice

1. The 38th cycle of PhD courses with administrative headquarters at the University of Campania *Luigi Vanvitelli* is established, subject to accreditation and verification of the maintenance of accreditation requirements by the Ministry of University and Research.
2. In the run-up to the aforementioned accreditation procedure for the 38th cycle, the competition is held, for qualifications and exams, for admission to the three-year PhD courses with administrative headquarters at the University of Campania Luigi Vanvitelli, listed below:
 - *PhD Course in Humanities and Social Sciences*
 01. PhD Course in Architecture and Cultural Heritage
 02. PhD Course in Comparative Law and Integration Processes
 03. PhD Course in Internationalisation of Legal systems and Fundamental Rights
 04. PhD Course in Mind Sciences
 05. PhD Course in History and Transmission of Cultural Heritage
 - *PhD School in Polytechnic and Basic Sciences*
 06. PhD Course in Science and Engineering for the Environment and Sustainability
 07. PhD course in Industrial and Information Engineering
 08. PhD Course in Mathematics, Physics and Engineering Applications
 09. PhD Course of National Interest in Made in Italy Design: Identity, innovation and sustainability
 10. Industrial PhD Course in Technologies for Resilient Living Environments
 - *PhD School in Life Sciences*
 11. PhD Course in Translational Medicine
 12. PhD Course in Biochemical and Biotechnological Science
 13. PhD Course in Biomolecular Sciences
 14. PhD Course in Medical Clinical and Experimental Sciences
 15. Doctoral Course of National Interest in Public Administration and Innovation for Disability and Social Inclusion.
3. The PhD Courses will start on December 1, 2022, except for the provisions of the current regulation on internationalisation and specific international agreements.
4. For each of the PhD Courses referred to in paragraph 2 above, a specific descriptive sheet (annexes 1 to 15) is attached to this notice, which is an integral part of it and which bears:
 - the Administrative Headquarters Department of the PhD Course;
 - the total number of places in the competition and their type;
 - the number of scholarships, type and indication of those reserved for students who have obtained the qualification required for admission to the PhD Courses;
 - the eventual curricula;
 - the procedures for carrying out the admission tests;
 - the web pages of the Department and the University where you can find any useful information with reference to the training path, the competition calendar and any useful notification for candidates
5. The number of places and scholarships indicated in the information sheets attached to this notice may be increased as a result of any additional financial resources of the University, regional and/or national and/or European and/or international, in particular, PNRR, PON-RI,



FSC, CAMPANIA, appropriate notice of each funding will be given on the University's website - www.unicampania.it on the page: *Dottorati di Ricerca* at the following link: <https://www.unicampania.it/index.php/didattica/dottorati-di-ricerca/isciversi-ad-un-dottorato>.

6. The number of scholarships may also be increased thanks to funding from public and/or private bodies, provided that the relevant agreement is concluded no later than the deadline for submitting applications to participate in the competition. In this case, the funding will not affect the total number of places planned under this notice for the PhD course.
7. The Administration reserves the right to revoke the competition notice, to suspend or postpone the competition tests or to, suspend or not proceed with the admission of the winners or to suspend or not award all the scholarships provided for in the notice of competition, due to needs that cannot currently be assessed or foreseen. In particular, the Administration reserves the right not to award the scholarships or to suspend their disbursement following the occurrence of unforeseen or unforeseeable circumstances resulting in the loss of both public and private funding.
8. This notice, written in Italian and translated into English, is published in the University of Campania *Luigi Vanvitelli's* Electronic Register Luigi Vanvitelli: www.unicampania.it – **Albo online**; this publication **has the status of official notification to the interested parties for all the indications contained in it**; therefore, candidates will not receive further communication.

The notice of this competition will also be published on the European Euraxess website and the Ministry of the University and Research website.

Any corrections will be announced exclusively, with the publication on the aforementioned University Digital register.

Art. 2

General Requirements for participation

1. Those who can apply to participate in the competition for admission to the PhD courses indicated in art. 1 co. 2 of this notice, without limits of age and nationality, must hold one of the following qualifications:
 - Master's degree awarded pursuant to Ministerial Decree no. 270/2004 (replacing no. 509/1999).
 - degree of at least four years, obtained in accordance with previous legal systems;
 - Academic qualification equivalent to an Italian degree of at least four years' duration obtained at a foreign university.
2. The application for participation may also be submitted by those who will obtain the qualification required for admission within the maximum term of **October 31 2022**, on the condition that on the date of submission of the application, they only need to take the degree exam and that they undertake to prove to have obtained the qualification, upon registration, on penalty of forfeiture of the same; the evaluation of these candidates, for the purposes of participation in the competition, will take into account the average of the grades obtained in the exams and the dissertation being drafted.
3. All candidates are admitted to the competition procedure subject to verification of self-certified declarations pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 445/2000 and subsequent modifications. The University can, at any time of the procedure, even after the start of the PhD courses, carry out checks on the truth of the statements and request the exhibition of the original documents. Within reasoning, the administration may order the exclusion of candidates from the competition procedure or the forfeiture of admission to the PhD Course at any time, without

prejudice to the requirements prescribed by this notice without prejudice to criminal responsibilities deriving from false declarations. This measure will be communicated to the person concerned by registered letter with return receipt.

Art. 3

Requirements for participation in reserved posts

1. **Only foreign university graduates possess** the degree required by the previous art. 2, co. may apply to participate in the competition for **reserved posts**, indicated in the information sheets attached to this notice. 1 or those pending the achievement pursuant to art. 2, co. 2.; in the absence of reserved posts, they may apply for participation in the competition for ordinary posts;
2. The candidates who compete in reserved posts with a degree obtained abroad that has not already been recognised as equivalent to an Italian degree, as per art. 2, paragraph 1 above, will have to apply for their suitability - solely for the purposes of admission to the PhD - to the PhD Admission Commission in compliance with current legislation. In this case, the application must be accompanied, under penalty of exclusion, by the following documents to be submitted using the online application procedure, referred to in Article 4 below:
 - a) qualification required for admission to the PhD Courses, translated into Italian or English by the competent diplomatic or consular representations or by an official translator;
 - b) application for a suitability judgement by the Selection Board.

It should be noted that, in case of admission to a PhD Course, for the issue of a visa, it will be necessary, in any case, to request the certificate of equivalence from the competent diplomatic authorities in the Country of origin.

3. **For holders of scholarships funded by foreign countries or under specific international mobility programmes and beneficiaries of Community and international collaboration projects**, the selection procedures are carried out by international panels and/or Bodies of the European Union within the framework of competitive financing procedures, which expressly provide for the registration to the PhD by the winners. Candidates who pass the selection tests are automatically admitted to the PhD course.

Art. 4

Application request (deadline and modalities)

1. The application request to participate in the competition must be completed and submitted **exclusively** electronically, accompanied by the required documentation, **under penalty of exclusion**, using the **appropriate online procedure**, available at: <https://pica.cineca.it/unicampania/dottorati37-innovazione//domande/>, **starting from 02:00 pm (Italian time) from June 15, 2022, and before and not past 02:00 pm (Italian time) of July 15, 2022.**

After this deadline, the system will automatically close and will not allow the application to be submitted.

The application for participating in the competition, submitted in different ways, will not be considered.

No documentation additions after the notice's above-mentioned deadline will be allowed.

Before the final closing of the application procedure, applicants must print the application, sign it and upload the PDF in the procedure, attaching a copy, in colour, of a valid identity document, the research project and other useful qualifications.

With the final closure of the online procedure, the application will automatically be submitted to the University; therefore, no delivery or mailing of material must be made to the Offices.



2. Candidates are requested to complete their competition application well before the closing date of this notice.
It is the responsibility of the candidates to verify the correct conclusion of the procedure. Complaints will not be accepted for any malfunctions of the IT system due to technical problems and/or overloads of the communication line and/or application systems.
3. Documents, qualifications, the research project and a colour photocopy of a valid identity document in PDF electronic format must be attached to the application.
It will be the candidate's responsibility to verify the correct uploading of all the required documents, taking into account that only and exclusively the correctly attached qualifications will be evaluated for the purposes of participation in the competition. The Administration assumes no responsibility in the case of illegible documentation presented in electronic format due to corrupted files or folders.
4. Applicants who intend to apply for more than one Course must submit as many applications as the selected Courses, attaching the required documentation for each application.
5. For all legal purposes, the application is to be considered a self-certification, pursuant to articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree 445/200 and subsequent amendments of the data contained therein and the attached documents.
6. For participation in the competition, candidates with **Italian citizenship** must provide for each application - under penalty of **exclusion from the competition**, before the expiry date of the deadline for applying - the payment of € 10.00 (euro ten) as a contribution to participate in the access exams of the PhD Course. The payment must be made with the same electronic procedure through the pagoPA system.
The above contribution will not be refunded under any circumstances.
Those who pay the fee in ways other than those described above or after the deadline will not be allowed to participate in the competition procedure.
Foreign citizens who do not hold Italian citizenship are exempt from paying the aforementioned contribution.
7. The candidate will be **excluded** from the competition who:
 - does not meet the general admission requirements referred to in art. 2 of this notice;
 - Whose application:
 - is not accompanied by a copy of an identity document and other mandatory documents (research project);
 - (*for the Italian candidate only*) is not accompanied by the payment of € 10.00 (euro ten) as a participation contribution;
 - (*for the candidate with a foreign qualification only*) is not accompanied by:
 - a) the academic qualification translated according to the provisions of the previous art. 3;
 - b) application for a judgement of suitability to the Selection Board in the event that it has not already been declared equivalent.

Art. 5

Documentation to be attached to the application.

1. For the evaluation of qualifications, candidates must attach the documents, dissertation and other qualifications referred to in the following art. 6, to the application to participate in the competition, in certified copy or in simple copy, of which the candidate declares the conformity to the original within the electronic application for participation.
2. For participation in the competition procedure for ordinary posts, attached documents can be drawn up in Italian, English, French or Spanish.



Documents drawn up in a different language must bear a certified Italian translation in accordance with the foreign text by the competent Italian diplomatic or consular representation, or by an official translator, or a declaration in substitute of the notoriety deed.

3. For participation in the competition procedure for reserved posts, the qualification required for admission must be translated into Italian or English, by the competent diplomatic or consular representations or by an official translator.
Additional documents and useful qualifications can be produced in Italian, English, French or Spanish and self-certified according to Italian law.
Subsequently, within 60 days of the publication of the general merit ranking, the winners must produce the Declaration of Validity of the degree required for admission.

Art. 6

Admission tests and assessable qualifications

1. The PhD admittance tests are designed to ascertain the candidate's aptitude for scientific research. The candidate must also demonstrate good knowledge of the foreign language indicated in the PhD course attached to this notice.
2. The selection for both reserved and ordinary competitions involves the **evaluation of the qualifications**, including the mandatory submission of a **research project**, drafted according to the format illustrated below, and an **oral test**.
The research project, of no more than 700 words, must indicate the following:
 1. Project title
 2. State of the Art;
 3. Objectives of the project and its connection to the PhD's own object;
 4. Methodology and related timing with respect to the 3 years of the PhD;
 5. Expected results and possible risk strategies;
 6. Degree of organisational and financial feasibility;
 7. Involvement of Italian and/or foreign research facilities and/or researchers, with related motivations;
 8. Essential bibliography up to a maximum of 12 titles (in addition to the 700 words).

The research project presented will not constitute a binding work programme in case of admission to the PhD course.

3. The **exam calendar will be announced on the Department's website**, indicated in the information sheet of each PhD course attached, by the Chairman of the Selection Board.
The publication of this notice and the data contained in the attached information sheet constitute a full notification. Therefore, candidates who have not been notified of their exclusion from the competition will have to take the examination according to the timetable indicated without any further notice
Any changes in the date and time of the selection tests will be published on the same website of the Department indicated in the information sheets of each PhD course attached

4. The Selection Boards referred to in Art. 7, for the evaluation of candidates, have 100 points divided as follows:

Qualifications: **max 40 points**
(including the research project max score 10 points)

Interview: **max 60 points**

The minimum score to access the interview (for both the reserved and ordinary competition) is at least 12 points.

The minimum score to pass the interview, for the ordinary competition only, is at least 42 points.

5. For the **evaluation of qualifications**, the autonomy of the Selection Board is resolute. For both types of posts, ordinary and reserved, the following documentation can be evaluated:

a) *The **graduation dissertation in full** (or, for undergraduate candidates only, the dissertation under filing countersigned by the supervisor and stamped by the reference department) can be assessed based on the content and consistency with the PhD or at least one of the Sectors in which the candidate participates.*

max 6 points

b) *The **degree mark** that can be evaluated according to proportional parameters (or equivalent characteristics for the reserved ranking); or, failing that, the weighted average marks of the exams taken (for those who will obtain a degree by October 31, 2022)*

max 10 points

c) *The **monographs and publications in peer-review journals** or collections can be assessed if they are specifically relevant to the Sector(s) subject of the PhD and have already been published or certified by the publisher as accepted and soon to be published; **Patents** assessable if specifically relevant to the Sector(s) subject of the PhD;*

max 8 points

d) *Post-graduate qualifications, such as the **specialisation diploma** and the **master's degree of at least one year awarded by universities or qualified research institutions** assessable if they are appropriate to the PhD Sector(s).*

max 2 points attributable

e) **Research collaboration grants** are assessable if consistent with the PhD Sector(s);
 - **scholarships** assessable if awarded following selection procedures carried out exclusively by Italian or foreign universities or primary research institutes;
***periods of study and research abroad** (including the Erasmus period) that can be assessed if carried out at universities or qualified research institutes for a continuous period of not less than 3 months;*
***the awards obtained by national and international Scientific Societies** that can be obtained if they are consistent with the PhD sector;*

max 2 points

f) **other documents** deemed useful by the selection board for a complete evaluation, such as:

- *participation in research activities* assessable if proven by a letter of reference from a university lecturer with ASN commission criteria or a qualified international researcher;
- *appointment as subject expert* assessable if decided before the date of issue of the notice;

max 2 points

g) the **research project**, in short form (no more than 700 words) prepared according to the indications referred to in co. 3 of this article

max 10 points

For those who obtain a degree before **October 31, 2022**, *the weighted average grade of the exams taken*, which replaces the grade referred to in letter b), shall be calculated:

- multiplying the grade of each exam taken at the date of submission of the application by the respective number of credits (30 cum laude is to be considered as 30);
- adding up all the results;
- dividing the result by the sum of the credits (those of the exams with grades);

–multiplying the average obtained by 110 and dividing the result by 30, thus obtaining the grade in hundred and tenths.

The weighted average is not required for undergraduate and graduate students from foreign Universities.

6. Only candidates who graduated abroad and Italian candidates residing or domiciled outside the Region will be able to participate in the interview. It will concern a discussion about the qualifications and the research project submitted and will be conducted electronically via Skype (or other similar tool) after verification of the applicant's identity by simultaneous presentation of a valid identification document, of which a copy in colour is already attached to the application form. The oral exam is public and will take place at the established time and in the presence of the other applicants who wish to be present.

It is forbidden to make audio/video recordings of the interview remotely through the computer platforms used. It is also forbidden for anyone to broadcast audio/video recordings made with instruments other than the platform.

The absence of the candidate on the day and time of the exam will be considered as a waiver of the exam itself, whatever the cause.

7. For the **evaluation of the oral exam** (interview), the autonomy of the Selection Board is resolute for both types of places, ordinary and reserved. The **evaluation criteria** are:

- a) **Clarity of exposition** **max 10** points
- b) **synthesis capacity** **max 5** points
- c) *critical spirit and adequate knowledge of the topics related to the titles presented*
max 20 points
- d) *ability to carry out part of the discussion in the foreign language* chosen from those indicated in the information sheet of each course attached to the notice
max 5 points
- e) *ability to answer in-depth questions about the research project presented*
max 20 points

Art. 7

Selection boards and their duties

1. For admission to the PhD Courses, the Selection Boards composed according to the provisions of art. 22 of the University Regulations containing the rules on PhD courses mentioned in the premises will be appointed, by Rectoral decree, within seven days of the deadline for submitting applications for admission to the competition.
2. The composition of the individual Commissions will be published on the University's website: www.unicampania.it on the page: *Dottorati di Ricerca* at the following link: <https://www.unicampania.it/index.php/didattica/dottorati-di-ricerca/isciversi-ad-un-dottorato>.
3. The individual Selection Boards will provide for, among other things:
 - the posting of the competition calendar on the website of the Department indicated in the attached PhD Course sheets, by the date indicated in the aforementioned sheets;
 - The publication of the qualifications evaluation results must take place at least three working days before the interview;
 - The timely publication of each evaluation (*qualification assessment and interview*) on the department's website indicated in the PhD program attached to the notice, according to the deadlines set out in the competition calendar.

4. The commission's work will begin no later than July 29, 2022, with the holding of the preliminary meeting to establish the criteria and methods of evaluation of the competition tests to ensure a suitable and transparent comparative evaluation of the candidates. It must be completed no later than 60 days from the same date of start of work.

Art. 8

Approval of the general merit ranking

1. For each selection, a rector's decree will be issued to approve the general merit ranking drawn up according to the descending order of the overall score achieved by each candidate. In the event of a tie between two or more candidates, the youngest candidate will have priority in the ranking.
2. If the *scholarships for the reserved rankings are not allocated, they will constitute savings in the University's financial statements, for the same purposes of internationalisation of PhD courses, in relation to the activation of the next cycle and to fill the related positions in the reserved rankings.*
3. The above-mentioned general rankings of merit relating to the individual competitions for admission to the PhD Courses - 38th cycle - are approved by the rector's decree within 30 days of the closure of the work of the admission commissions and will be announced on the University website - www.unicampania.it at the page: *Dottorati di Ricerca*, at the following link: <https://www.unicampania.it/index.php/didattica/dottorati-di-ricerca/iscrivere-ad-un-dottorato> by October 28, 2022.
This will be an official notice to the interested parties. **Therefore, no personal communications will be sent to the candidates.**

Art. 9

Admission of public employees and medical area postgraduates

1. Public employees admitted to a PhD course benefit, for the normal duration of the course, from the leave provided for by the collective contract or, if employed under public law, from extraordinary leave for study purposes, compatibly with the needs of the administration, pursuant to article 2 of law no. 476, August 13, 1984, with or without grants and unless explicitly waived, only if they are enrolled for the first time in a PhD course, regardless of the subject area. Without prejudice to the right to the *budget* for the research activity carried out in Italy and abroad referred to in article 9, paragraph 4 of the Ministerial Decree 226/2021.
2. In accordance with the provisions of Article 8, paragraph 1 of the Ministerial Decree 226/2021, the University allows the joint attendance of the PhD course and a medical specialisation course, in compliance with the following conditions:
 - a) compatibility, also in consideration of the distance between the facilities, of the activities and commitment envisaged by the specialisation school and the PhD course, certified by the board of the medical specialisation school and by the PhD board;
 - b) incompatibility between the PhD scholarship and the fees, however, denominated, received in relation to the activities of the specialisation school.
3. In the cases of joint attendance referred to in this article, the request for reduction of PhD activities is accepted by the faculty of the PhD course after a positive evaluation of the consistency of the research activities already carried out in the medical specialisation course, with the PhD project. For the purposes of accepting the application referred to in this paragraph, the opinion of compatibility, expressed by the board of the specialisation school, of the PhD project with the didactic purposes of the same specialisation school is also required. If

the application referred to in this paragraph is accepted, the PhD course has a duration of no less than two years.

4. Doctors in specialist training, by virtue of the incompatibility provided for in paragraph 1 letter b) of this article and art. 7 lett. b) of Ministerial Decree 226/2021, cannot receive the PhD scholarship concurrently with other funds, however, denominated, received in relation to the activities of the specialisation school. If they hold a PhD position with a scholarship, they will be able to benefit from it only at the end of the specialisation course.

Art. 10

Admission of company employees to reserved places (PhD Executive Path)

1. In order to encourage interaction with companies, the University can activate Industrial PhD courses with the possibility of allocating a share of the available places, based on specific agreements, to company employees engaged in highly qualified activities which are admitted to the PhD Course after passing the relative selection.
The places reserved for the PhD Executive path are indicated in the attached descriptive sheet of each Course.
2. These company employee paths are incompatible with the enjoyment of a scholarship.
3. Without prejudice to the coverage of the financial sustainability of the PhD course on the basis of the minimum number of scholarships required for activation, the reservation of places without a scholarship to employees of companies in the context of courses with specific curricula aimed at fostering relations with companies and with the production world is exceptionally allowed.

Art. 11

Incompatibility

1. The enrolment in PhD courses is not compatible with a simultaneous enrolment in degree courses, non-medical specialisation courses, first and second-level masters or other PhD courses in Italy or abroad.
2. Students enrolled in Bachelor's or Master of Science/Specialist degree Courses, as well as postgraduates enrolled in Non-Medical Specialisation Schools who, having a degree, intend to enrol in a PhD course, have to request the temporary suspension of their first enrolment.

Art. 12

Registration of winners

1. For the purpose of admission to the PhD course, the **winning candidates**, with or without a scholarship, must submit a registration application and make the related declarations **from 2.00 pm on October 31, 2022, and no later than 2:00 pm on November 08, 2022**, exclusively according to the operating methods that will be published by October 28, 2022, on **the University website - www.unicampania.it** on the page: *Dottorati di Ricerca* at the following link: <https://www.unicampania.it/index.php/didattica/dottorati-di-ricerca/iscrivarsi-ad-un-dottorato>.
Those who do not participate within the deadline will be considered to have lapsed to all effects, and the vacancies will be assigned to those who hold a useful position in the merit ranking.

The rankings will be scrolled for vacancies in accordance with the terms shown in the following chart:

- After the deadline of November 25, 2022, further scrolls will be made in case of renunciation of the winners or if additional resources become available within 30 days from the start of the PhD courses, scheduled for December 1 2022.
- Starting from January 02, 2023, no PhD positions made available will be assigned; the same will be used for the activation of the next cycle.
- Winners who graduated before October 31, 2022, must self-certify the achievement of the qualification by the date scheduled for enrolment, under penalty of forfeiture of the same.
- In case of useful placement in several rankings of different PhD Courses, the candidate must choose only one PhD Course.
- Eligible non-winners are invited to view the page** indicated above in order to acquire useful information regarding any possible update of the general merit list.

Art. 13

Scholarships, taxes and contributions

- The scholarships, which can also be financed with the help of several funding sources, have a total duration of at least three years.
They are assigned to those enrolled in PhD courses according to the order defined in the general merit ranking for the entire course duration. They are renewed annually after positive verification of the completion of the activity program envisaged for each year.
The faculty board established the renewal procedures and codified them in the course regulations. If the scholarship is not renewed, or if the student renounces it, the unused amount of the scholarship is reinvested by the University to fund PhDs.
- The amount of the scholarship for the academic year 2022/2023 is equal to 16,243.00 and is paid in monthly instalments postponed to the frequency and activity of study and research, with the exception of PhD students with foreign citizenship, for whom the disbursement is always carried out in advance with monthly instalments.
- The increase in the scholarship is established at 50%, for a total period not exceeding twelve months, for carrying out research activities abroad authorised by the faculty board. This period can be extended up to an overall maximum of eighteen months for PhDs co-supervised with foreign subjects or activated pursuant to article 3, paragraph 2, of the Ministerial Decree 226/2021.
- For carrying out the research activity in Italy and abroad, in addition to the scholarship, the student is ensured a *budget* adequate to the type of PhD course and the specific discipline, and in any case, not less than 10% of the amount of the scholarship itself, for the first year of the course, and in an amount equal to 20% of the scholarship amount starting from the second year. With the exception of PhD courses of national interest, for which the budget allocated for each year of the course is always equal to 20%. The aforementioned *budget* is also ensured

for PhD students without a scholarship. It will be assigned to the administrative headquarters department of the PhD course to support the research and training activities of the PhD student in conjunction with the start of the courses.

5. If the funds attributed for carrying out research and training activities of the PhD students of the third year have not been completely used, the PhD Coordinator can exceptionally authorise the missions of PhD students of the first year or PhD students of the second year for which funds have not yet been allocated.
6. The PhD student is authorised by the coordinator, with the approval of the supervisor, for the following expenses:
 - a) missions of PhD students in Italy and abroad, registration for conferences, seminars, etc.;
 - b) consumables for research in which PhD students are involved (For example, chemical reagents, electrical and electronic material, stationery, etc.);
 - c) goods/equipment (e.g.: hardware, software, scientific equipment)). The assets must be inventoried and, at the end of the PhD cycle, will remain the property of the University. Of course, it is not in any case possible to purchase goods/equipment for personal use (for example, cell phones, tablets, etc.);
 - d) publishing costs;
 - e) specific research training (e.g. language courses, advanced training courses, etc.);
 - f) events in the organisation of which PhD students are directly involved (for example, PhD Day);
 - g) in the event of availability of unused funds, the faculty board may decide to use them for the payment of the travel of foreign commission members for the dissertation, which provides for the conferment of the additional foreign qualification to the PhD student (eg, doctor europaeus).
7. Also, PhD students authorised for research stays abroad during which they benefit from the scholarship increase are entitled to reimbursement for missions to encourage international exchanges.
8. The PhD scholarship is subject to the payment of separately managed INPS social security contributions, pursuant to article 2, paragraph 26, of law no. 335, to the extent of two-thirds paid by the administration and one-third by the scholarship holder. PhD students benefit from the protections and related rights.
9. The scholarship for attending the PhD is compatible with other personal income received in the calendar year of greater use of the amount up to the limit of the scholarship itself. All personal income deriving from work activities is considered to verify this threshold, excluding the scholarship amount or any income support benefits paid according to the scholarship (such as the maternity allowance).
10. In case of withdrawal from the course, the PhD student is required to return the scholarship instalments already received in the only cases in which the student exceeds the income limit, as per the preceding paragraph, or is in one of the cases of incompatibility envisaged by current laws and these regulations.
11. If the candidate has already received a scholarship for a PhD course, he/she cannot apply for a second time.
12. Scholarships may not be combined with other scholarships for any reason whatsoever, except for those awarded by national or foreign institutions to supplement, stays abroad, training or research activities of scholarship holders abroad.
Scholarships for PhD attendance are compatible with Erasmus scholarships.

13. By decree of the rector, after deliberation by the competent academic bodies, the following items are established:
- a) the amount of the contribution for access and attendance to the PhD courses, as well as the conditions for exemption from payment of the same, providing that the contribution share of the PhD student with foreign citizenship and without a scholarship cannot exceed half of the sum provided for the Italian PhD student;
 - b) the methods of disbursement of the scholarships.

Art. 14

One-off contribution for foreign students residing abroad and Italians not resident in the Campania Region

1. A “one-off” contribution for accommodation costs is envisaged. This contribution will be attributed, as a priority, to registered foreign students residing abroad or outside the Campania Region, without them making a specific request; subsequently, on the basis of financial availability, to registered Italian students not resident in the Campania Region, admitted without a scholarship, provided that they have requested it at the time of the application submission for participation in the competition by selecting the item “*One-off contribution request*”.
2. The minimum amount of the “one-off” payment will be defined according to the number of eligible persons up to the specific competition budget, while the maximum pro-capita amount may not exceed € 5.000.
This contribution must be returned in case of renunciation of the PhD Course during the first year of attendance.

Art. 15

Fee for the right to university studies

1. **By the deadline for enrolment**, Italian and foreign winners, with or without a scholarship, are required to pay the virtual stamp of € 16.00 and the regional tax for the right to university study for the academic year. 2022/2023, determined on the basis of the economic condition of the PhD student commensurate with the level of the Indicator of the Equivalent Economic Situation (ISEEU) relating to benefits for the right to university study.
2. **The ISEEU certificate** relating to your family unit **must be requested from the competent offices responsible for issuing the certification at least 10 days before the start of enrolment**, in order not to fall into the highest income bracket automatically.

Art. 16

Obligations and rights of PhD students

1. The PhD course requires an exclusive and full-time commitment, without prejudice to the provisions of Article 12, paragraph 4 and Article 10, paragraph 2, letter *b*) of the Ministerial Decree 226/2021. 2. PhD students, with or without a scholarship, are required to:
 - carry out the training course approved by the faculty board with exclusive commitment;
 - regularly attend the course activities provided by the faculty board;
 - participate in common courses within the PhD school;
 - present oral or written reports on the activities and research carried out;
 - draw up personal registers of the activities referred to in paragraph 4 below;
 - comply with whatever else is approved by the faculty board or is provided for by the regulations for the implementation of specific funds to cover the PhD scholarship;

- to write the PhD dissertation with original contributions at the end of the course.
- 2. PhD students must acquire at least 60 credits each year, distributed according to the training program agreed upon with the tutor and approved by the Faculty Board, consistent with the training offer advertised annually on the website of the department concerned on the PhD page. Where required by specific funding projects from which individual courses can benefit, the above credits per hour will be converted into training hours that the PhD students are obliged to attend.
- 3. The activities of PhD students must be recorded in special personal registers and include: study activities, research activities, personal study, bibliographic and archive research, ongoing checks, participation in seminars, courses and conferences, activities at facilities outside the University (other universities, research institutions, companies) in Italy and abroad, any additional learning and tutoring activities and whatever else may be provided for by the Faculty Board leading to the completion of the course. It is absolutely forbidden to carry out research activities related to the PhD at private institutions or structures unless authorised by the teaching staff. Violation of this rule will result in the forfeiture of the PhD course.
- 4. The legitimacy of the different activities carried out by the PhD students is certified by the Coordinators based on the indications provided by the supervisor and by the co-supervisor/s.
- 5. At the end of each year of the Course, the Faculty Board, based on a detailed report on the activities and research carried out by each PhD student, decides on the admission to the following year or proposes to the rector the exclusion from the course.
- 6. For proven reasons, the PhD student may ask the faculty board for an extension of the time allowed for the presentation of the PhD thesis, for a maximum duration of twelve months, without further financial charges.
- 7. The faculty board may decide to extend the duration of the PhD course for a period not exceeding twelve months for justified scientific needs linked, among other things, to needs in the context of co-safeguards lasting more than three years or the need for a proven increase in scientific productivity, (for example: *for the submission or outcome of a patent application as well as in the event of an extension of the duration of a research project of significant national or international interest*); in cases of extension, the corresponding duration of the scholarship must be ensured with funds from the university budget. Therefore the motivated proposal for extension of the faculty board will be submitted for the approval of the Board of Directors for the related financial verification. The beneficiary PhD students will be obliged to comply with everything resolved by the faculty with reference to the extended training course, including carrying out the course activities.
- 8. For proven reasons provided for by current legislation, such as maternity, serious illness and civil service, PhD students may request the suspension of the course for a maximum duration of six months. No scholarship or other equivalent funding is envisaged for the duration of the suspension.
- 9. Following communication from the course coordinator, the faculty board takes note of the suspensions. The suspension of more than thirty days for one of the reasons indicated in the previous paragraph 9 of this article entails the obligation to fully recover the periods of interruption of the activity and, therefore, in such cases, the duration of the training course will be extended, for a period corresponding to that of the interruption.
- 10. The extension and suspension periods referred to in paragraphs 7, 8 and 9 of this article may not exceed a total of eighteen months, except in specific cases provided for by law.

11. Without prejudice to the interventions for the right to study as per legislative decree March 29, 2012, n. 68.
12. Without prejudice to the application of the rules for the protection of parenthood referred to in the decree of the Minister of Labour and Social Security of July 12, 2007, published in the Official Gazette of October 23, 2007, no. 247, PhD students on leave retain the right to the scholarship that will be paid at the end of the suspension period, i.e. the resumption of the course attendance up to the total duration of the scholarship itself.
13. It is the responsibility of the PhD Course Coordinator to promptly notify the competent office of the interruption of the PhD student's activity for the consequent administrative measures.
14. The faculty board may authorise the PhD student to carry out paid activities that allow them to acquire skills relating to the educational environment of the PhD after evaluating the compatibility of the same activities with the successful performance of the training, teaching and research activities of the PhD course. In such cases, the maximum income limit, which the PhD student can receive as compatible with the scholarship, is equal to the amount of the scholarship itself.
15. For each PhD student, the faculty board normally provides for the carrying out of research and training activities, consistent with the PhD project, at highly qualified institutions abroad, for a total period not exceeding twelve months. This period can be extended up to an overall maximum of eighteen months for PhDs co-supervised with foreign subjects or for those in aggregate form activated pursuant to article 3, paragraph 2, of the Ministerial Decree 226/2021. In planning the training activities abroad, the board can take into account the proposal of the supervisor and the co-supervisor/s of the PhD student, who must propose the program of activities, the title of the project and the invitation letter from the foreign supervisor. For periods of attendance abroad, the scholarship is increased by 50%.
16. PhD students have an obligation of confidentiality in relation to the research activities carried out with external bodies.
17. The use of research grants by PhD students without a scholarship is allowed as long as the topic the grant refers to is similar to the topics of the PhD in the judgement of the Faculty Board.
18. Following the enrolment to the course, the University email address will be activated for each PhD student through which he/she will receive institutional communications. Reading the institutional email is mandatory, as well as being constantly informed via the University and Department website for general and specific communications relating to the PhD. The PhD student is also obliged to register on the ministerial site on the MIUR Login page to be selected as a research potential of the University.
19. As an integral part of the training project, PhD students can carry out, subject to authorisation from the faculty board and without any increase in the scholarship:
 - tutoring, including paid tutoring, of undergraduate and master's degree students;
 - supplementary teaching activities, within the limit of forty hours for each academic year. For the activities referred to in this paragraph, PhD students are paid the grants referred to in article 1, paragraph 1, letter *b*), of the decree-law of May 9, 2003, n. 105, converted, with modifications, by the law July 11, 2003, n. 170. 2. The performance of the above activities must be indicated in the personal registers. This is without prejudice to specific teaching collaborations provided for by specific national rules for which the related discipline shall apply. All other forms of teaching are strictly prohibited, and it is the responsibility of the Coordinator to supervise compliance with this provision.

20. Art. 17

Discipline of PhDs

1. The qualification of PhD, abbreviated to “Dr Ric.” is released following the positive evaluation of a research dissertation that contributes to the advancement of knowledge and methodologies in the chosen field of research.
2. The qualification of PhD is conferred by the rector, to the extent permitted, who certifies the achievement with the release of a parchment certificate.

Art. 18

Processing of personal data

1. Pursuant to art. 13 and 14 of the GDPR - General Regulation on Data Protection EU no. 2016/679, the personal data provided by candidates will be collected at the University of Campania *Luigi Vanvitelli* for the purposes of selection management and will be processed in paper form and through an automated database. The provision of such data is mandatory to verify the requirements of participation in the selection and its management.
2. The data subject has the rights in articles 15 to 22 of the aforementioned EU Regulation 2016/679, including the right to access the data concerning the data subject, as well as certain complementary rights, including the right to have incorrect, incomplete or collected data corrected, updated, completed or deleted if not complying with the law, as well as the right to oppose the processing for legitimate reasons.
3.
